Term 1

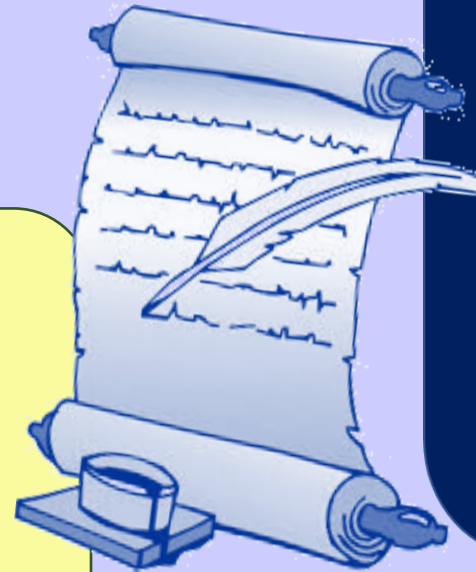
